Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to perform their services and run their everyday business. What we do	
How does Greenspring Advisors, LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards (such as password protection or encryption) and restricting access to physical files (such as locked cabinets or building).
How does Greenspring Advisors, LLC collect my personal information? Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account, I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account – unless you tell us otherwise.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership and/or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership and/or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or service to you.
